Village of Minoa

Local Law No. Three (3) of the year 2007.

A local law amending, supplementing and repealing parts of Chapter 151 of the Village of Minoa Municipal Code.

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Minoa as follows:

Section One (1). Section 151-2(A) of the Code of the Village of Minoa shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following language:

- A. The Village has entered into a lease agreement with the Onondaga County Water Authority for the control, maintenance and operation of the Village water system. It is the intent of the Village of Minoa to continue to furnish an adequate supply of pure and wholesome water to the residences and business establishments in the Village and its immediate vicinity; and also to supply sufficient water with sufficient pressure in its water supply system to adequately protect the buildings in the Village from damage of destruction by fire and to permit the residents of the Village to have the protected rate of the fire rating organization on their fire insurance for both their buildings and personal property. The foregoing notwithstanding, the Village has deemed it in their best interest, and that of its residents, to repeal certain provisions of Chapter 151 relative to administration.

Section Two (2). Section 151-3 of the Code of the Village of Minoa shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following language:

This chapter shall be applicable to all property owners and water users within the Village of Minoa and all water users outside of the Village of Minoa which users receive water pursuant to the Onondaga County Water Authority lease agreement with the Village of Minoa.

Section Three (3). Section 151-4 of the Code of the Village of Minoa shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following language:

For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this chapter, the Customer Rules (Revised Rules adopted April 14, 1999 and any amendments thereof) are hereby incorporated as if fully set forth herein and enacted as laws of the Village pertaining to its Village water service as of the effective date hereof.

Section Four (4). Sections 151-5, 6, 7, 8, 10, 11, 14, 15, 16, 19, 20, and 21 of the Code of the Village of Minoa are hereby repealed in their entirety, with the remainder of Chapter 151 being not otherwise affected and remaining in full force and effect.

Section Five (5) EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
