The regularly scheduled meeting of the Village Board of the Village of Minoa was held at the Municipal Building in the Village Board Room, 240 N. Main St, on May 5, 2008.

Mayor Donovan opened the meeting at 9:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance led by Trustee Champagne.

Steve Giarrusso, Supervisor for the Waste Water Treatment Facility, explained that the Village of Minoa is looking at vehicles that work on alternative fuels. He said that diesel is currently over \$4.00 per gallon for diesel and quickly rising. Mr. Giarrusso said they are reviewing a garbage truck that works on compressed natural gas and the City of Syracuse is currently using the same truck. He said they had looked at the truck and met with Barry Carr, Clean Communities of CNY, to discuss funding opportunities. Mr. Giarrusso said that Clean Communities of CNY is an organization that will help the Village of Minoa find grant money and available funds if the Village joins the coalition. He said the Village can withdraw from the organization at any time. Mr. Giarrusso said

that the grant information was also sent to Mackenzie Hughes LLP (Village grant writers). He said that by participating in the coalition they will contact Clean Energy who will then provide a demo natural gas garbage truck to the Village of Minoa for one week to see if it fits the village's needs without any commitment.

Mr. Giarrusso said that natural fuel is only \$1.71 per gallon and the Village of Minoa is considering a conversion to one of their existing vehicles and the coalition will assist with the search for grant funds for the conversion. He said it may be able to get a truck that runs on clean energy with zero emissions and fueling can be done in Syracuse, NY. Mr. Giarrusso said joining the coalition is an opportunity to potentially save money and to also save the environment by reducing emissions.

Trustee Theobald asked if the vehicles using this fuel had enough power to do the job and Mr. Giarrusso said that it was and that the City of Syracuse is currently using some natural gas vehicles. Mr. Giarrusso said an added bonus was that the compressed natural gas vehicles made less noise.

Trustee Champagne said that eventually by 2010 there will be restrictions on emissions and conversions. He said that if conversion were not made, then the vehicles would need to go to regeneration stations for cleaning and would cost approximately \$300.00 each visit.

Trustee Theobald said that if they are going to help with grant applications and it wouldn't cost the Village of Minoa anything to join, then it would be worth it.

Mayor Donovan said the DPW would handle the demo and test it for fuel mileage and capacity ability. He said the vehicles would be fueled on Teall Avenue, Syracuse, NY. He said the opportunities are there to have our own fuel station, but that is beyond where we are at right now. Mayor Donovan said that fill time is no longer than it is for diesel and they are reviewing it carefully. He said the projected cost for a diesel garbage truck is \$175,000 and a compressed natural gas garbage truck is \$215,000, but with environmental incentives they could be about the same price. Mayor Donovan said the vehicle would cost more initially, but ultimately it would equal out over time and the compressed natural gas truck would be environmentally friendly. He said he would let the Board know when the truck would be in Minoa so they could all review the packer.

Discussion ensued regarding emissions and fuel costs.

A motion was made by Trustee Champagne and seconded by Trustee Brazill giving permission to Mayor Donovan to sign the Memorandum of Understanding with Clean Communities of CNY for the purpose of exploring natural gas vehicle options. All in favor. Motion carried.

TRUSTEES' REPORT

Trustee Champagne reported that he and Clerk/Treasurer Snider had completed the six week course at BOCES for the Dreamweaver software program and they had learned a lot to help with updating the village website.

Trustee Theobald said he that he attended the Mayors' Association Meeting which was held at the Onondaga County Department of Emergency Management and that it was an impressive meeting.

Trustee Theobald said the Memorial Day Parade was on schedule. He said the American Legion Post 1102 had selected an essay winner and the military speaker, singer and clergy were all set. He said the village would utilize the golf carts again this year and reminded the Board that parade was scheduled for May 26, 2008 at 9:00 a.m.

Trustee Brazill said he had received the balance of the newsletter information he had requested and the newsletter would be mailed out that week.

MAYOR'S REPORT

Mayor Donovan said he was pleased with the attendance at the Mayors' Association Meeting and felt that it was a good experience for everyone to see the Onondaga County Emergency Management Operations Center. Mayor Donovan said he hopes that the Town Critical Response Committee would have a drill in which the Village of Minoa could participate having everyone split into local and county Emergency Operation Centers to practice their communication skills in the event of a disaster.

Mayor Donovan said he has spent a lot of time on the Minoa Farms project and the improvements over the past 6 to 8 weeks have been incredible and he thinks that it will only get better. Trustee Theobald agreed and said that Ryan Homes seems to be more conscientious of the parking and traffic problems near the model home. Mayor Donovan said that he has been working with the developer to make Minoa Farms more attractive, as well as trying to address the concerns of the residents in the area.

A motion was made by Trustee Champagne and seconded by Trustee Theobald authorizing Mayor Donovan to sign the Onondaga County Multi-Jurisdictional All-Hazard Mitigation Plan Authorization and Letter of Intent to Participate pending the review and recommendation of Attorney Primo. All in favor. Motion carried.






