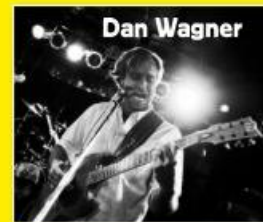

Teal Ribbon Run and Walk added to Festival in the Park

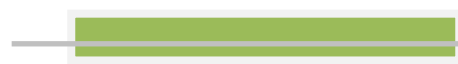

The Teal Ribbon Run benefits Ovarian Cancer Research, Awareness, Education and local support. Ovarian Cancer is the leading cause of death from GYN cancer. The symptoms are not specific (like pain or bleeding) and it is typically not diagnosed in an annual exam.

You can help make a difference:

1. Register to Run or Walk at TealRibbonRun.org. Join the the Trappers II Team. Your registration fee may be IRS tax deductible.
2. Make an IRS tax deductible donation to HopeforHeather.org.
3. Raise awareness by asking friends, neighbors, family to sponsor yourself (or your pet) as a runner or walker.
4. This is a family friendly event so strollers, wheel chairs and dogs on a short leash are welcome.
5. Volunteer as a course monitor near your home. Please pre-register as a volunteer at TealRibbonRun.org (no cost registration)
6. Setup your lawn chairs and boom-box near the street and cheer on the walkers and runner. This is an excellent opportunity to show younger family members how participate to make a difference in the community.
