## News from the Mayor

Who would believe that fall is here already! With school starting and the State Fair already past, reality is quickly setting in. As we enter the fall season, I would take this opportunity to up-date you as to the progress of some of the projects that started this year in the Village. I like to start with the Smith's Market location. This project is owned and developed by Empire Management. The main store will house retail space and a Subway. The new building was slated to be a convenience store; unfortunately, the perspective owner of that business could not get financing to bring that use to fruition and that business currently is being projected as a video rental store. I'm not giving up on a convenience store just yet. The activity now underway in the Village has renewed the interest of perspective businesses that I will continue to pursue.

The Minoa Farms project on Baird St. was the next project to start. This 240 home development finally started after 9 years of planning. In spite of the weather the developer (Minoa Farms LLC.) hopes to host the Parade of Homes next spring. This development will include six lakes and a passive park which will be dedicated to the Village. Home construction is scheduled to start this fall.

The next major project to start is our Municipal Building, in spite of the weather, progress is being made. The site is finally completely cleared and footings are now being poured on the north end of the project. The target at this point is to get the facility enclosed before winter sets in. Unfortunately the severe weather in the South complicates the delivery of some construction materials. Final completion is scheduled for July next year.

Where are the fire trucks, you ask? You are protected without missing a beat. We have an engine and a squad responding from our DPW garage and the balance are responding from Station 2. We are currently adding an addition to our DPW garage. When completed, before winter, it will house two engines and a squad until the new fire house is complete.

Our new web site is currently under construction. Hopefully, by the next newsletter that will be operational.

It has been an unbelievably busy year for our Village; I would like to publicly thank everyone involved for their support and hard work to make everything come together so we can conduct business as usual while all this activity is taking place. School is back in session; wet slippery conditions will soon be upon us, be safe and have a fun filled fall.
